Job Description

Support for Tropical Initiatives in Poverty Alleviation (STIPA) seeks a Chief of Party (COP) for an upcoming USAID funded Kenya Health Partnerships for Quality Services (KHPQS) – HIV, FP/RMNCAH, Nutrition, WASH, DREAMS and OVC Program. The project will support the Government of Kenya (GoK) in attaining its goal of addressing the HIV/AIDS response, safeguarding the rights and welfare of children and adolescents impacted by HIV/AIDS, and ensuring equitable access to and use of quality primary health care services including/RMNCAH, Nutrition, WASH services by the most vulnerable. The project will contribute to attaining the Sustainable Development Goals, which seek to attain the health and overall well-being of men, women, children, and adolescents.

The COP is responsible for overall management and operations of the project and is the key liaison with USAID. S/he supervises project implementation and ensures the project meets stated goals and reporting requirement. The COP takes a leadership role in coordination among USAID and key stakeholders and other implementing partners. The COP position requires political savvy, as s/he interacts with numerous GoK institutions and senior-level national and county-level government officials.

- Ten years of experience in a senior role leading a complex technical service delivery program of similar scope and dollar value.
- A Master's degree in social sciences, public health, medicine, management, business administration or a related field.
- Seven years of demonstrated experience in partnership building, especially with government representatives, donors, the private sector and local community organizations.
