

## **Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning Specialist – Kenya Health Partnership for Quality Services (KHPQS)**

### **Job Description**

Support for Tropical Initiatives in Poverty Alleviation (STIPA) seeks a Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning Specialist (MEL) for an upcoming USAID funded Kenya Health Partnerships for Quality Services (KHPQS) – HIV, FP/RMNCAH, Nutrition, WASH, DREAMS and OVC Program. The project will support the Government of Kenya (GoK) in attaining its goal of addressing the HIV/AIDS response, safeguarding the rights and welfare of children and adolescents impacted by HIV/AIDS, and ensuring equitable access to and use of quality primary health care services including/RMNCAH, Nutrition, WASH services by the most vulnerable. The project will contribute to attaining the Sustainable Development Goals, which seek to attain the health and overall well-being of men, women, children, and adolescents.

The MEL Specialist is responsible for leading the design and implementation of the program monitoring and evaluation framework and information system to track delivery against targets, outcomes and impacts. The MEL leads the analysis of data collected for assessment of progress and areas of improvement and overall data management. S/he guides reporting processes amongst technical staff and consolidate program reports, and promotes learning and knowledge sharing of best practices and lessons learned. S/he supports all the technical staff in MEL functions and manages any MEL related staff in the program.

### **Required Experience**

- A Master's degree in a relevant discipline such as mathematics, statistics, informatics, or a related field with knowledge/skills of Geographical Information Systems and information technology.
- At least ten years of experience implementing monitoring and evaluating activities for complex programs in developing countries.
- Demonstrated experience in providing technical support, setting up and managing M&E systems that track performance as per the objectives of this activity (e.g. service integration and performance against each result area) and in the application of statistical methods and database management.
